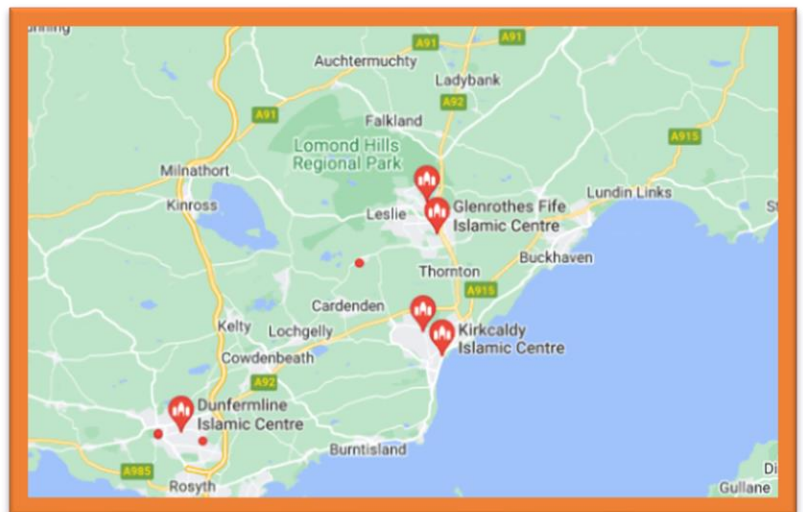


MOSQUES

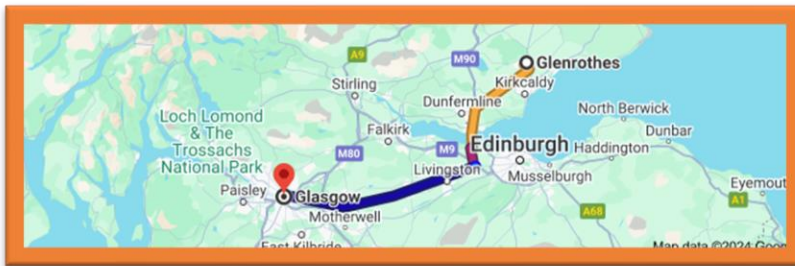

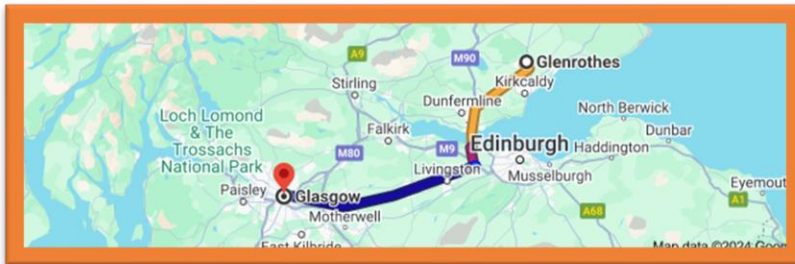
BUSES
